The Georgia Association for the Management of Educational Information Systems (GAMEIS) is the only education-based state-wide IT oriented organization of its kind in Georgia. Our organization is not supported by the State Department of Education, and not sponsored by a specific vendor. The membership of GAMEIS is made up of Information Technology professionals from school systems throughout the state. The organization relies upon sponsorship from vendors across the entire Information Technology spectrum to support its annual conference. As such, GAMEIS offers the following sponsorship opportunities.

Silver Level Sponsor (21): For a registration fee of \$500, silver sponsors are provided exhibit space in the sponsor showcase. (Additional charges for electricity, Internet connection, etc. may be levied, dependent upon requirements of the host facility.) The sponsor showcase is open all day Thursday and on Friday morning. Time is provided in the agenda for attendees to visit the sponsor showcase. Each sponsor is introduced at the opening ceremonies, and is given an opportunity to welcome attendees to his respective exhibit. Each booth will be allowed two people. There is a \$100 fee for each additional person sharing the booth exceeding the two allowed.

Gold Level Sponsor (20): Gold sponsors are afforded the same privileges as silver level sponsors. In addition, gold level sponsors are invited to present a forty five minute breakout session relating to a specific strand or theme (networking, web content, applications, etc.) of the conference on Wednesday or Thursday afternoons. The topic for the breakout session will be selected by the GAMEIS Executive Committee, and should be delivered as an educational and informative topic for the benefit of the individuals attending the session. Gold level sponsors are called upon to make a \$1,000 contribution to the conference. Each booth will be allowed two people. There is a \$100 fee for each additional person sharing the booth exceeding the two allowed.

Platinum Level Sponsor (5): Platinum level sponsors make a \$2,000 contribution to the GAMEIS conference; and are invited to deliver a keynote presentation to the entire conference membership, in addition to being afforded all the privileges of a silver sponsorship. Platinum level sponsors will be selected by the GAMEIS Executive Committee, and the keynote presentation is to be coordinated with the Executive Committee, to

insure that it follows the overall conference theme. Each booth will be allowed two people. There is a \$100 fee for each additional person sharing the booth exceeding the two allowed.

President's Reception Sponsorship (1): \$3,000 contribution. This year's reception will be held at Trustee's Garden immediately following the last breakout session of the day on Thursday and consist of low country boil and beverages.
